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**A = ADMINISTRATION:** The gift of administration is the divine ability to organize multiple tasks and groups of people to accomplish tasks. Luke 14:28–30; Acts 6:1–7; 1 Cor. 12:28

**C = CRAFTSMANSHIP:** The gift of craftsmanship is the divine ability to plan, build, and work with your hands in construction environments. Exodus 30:22, 31:3–11; Acts 18:2–3

**E = EVANGELISM:** The gift of evangelism is the divine ability to help non-Christians take the necessary steps to becoming a follower of Jesus. Acts 8:5–6, 8:26–40, 14:21; Eph. 4:11–14

**X = EXHORTATION:** The gift of exhortation is the divine ability to strengthen, comfort or urge others to action. Acts 14:22; Romans 12:8; 1 Timothy 4:13; Hebrews 10:24–25

**G = GIVING:** The gift of giving is the divine ability to produce wealth and to give above and beyond your normal offerings. Mark 12:41–44; Romans 12:8; 2 Corinthians 8:1–7, 9:2–7 65

**H = HELPS:** The gift of helps is the divine ability to work in a supportive role for the accomplishment of tasks. Mark 15:40–41; Acts 9:36; Romans 16:1–2; 1 Corinthians 12:28

**K = HOSPITALITY:** The gift of hospitality is the divine ability to create warm, welcoming environments for others. Acts 16:14– 15; Romans 12:13, 16:23; Hebrews 13:1–2; 1 Peter 4:9

**I = INTERCESSION:** The gift of intercession is the divine ability to stand in the gap in prayer for others believing for profound results. Hebrews 7:25; Colossians 1:9–12, 4:12–13; James 5:14–16

**M = MERCY:** The gift of mercy is the divine ability to feel empathy and to care for those who are hurting in any way. Matthew 9:35–36; Mark 9:41; Romans 12:8; 1 Thess. 5:14

**S = SERVICE:** The gift of serving is the divine ability to do small or great tasks in working for the overall good of the body of Christ. Acts 6:1–7; Romans 12:7; Galatians 6:10; 1 Timothy 1:16–18; Titus 3:14

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
